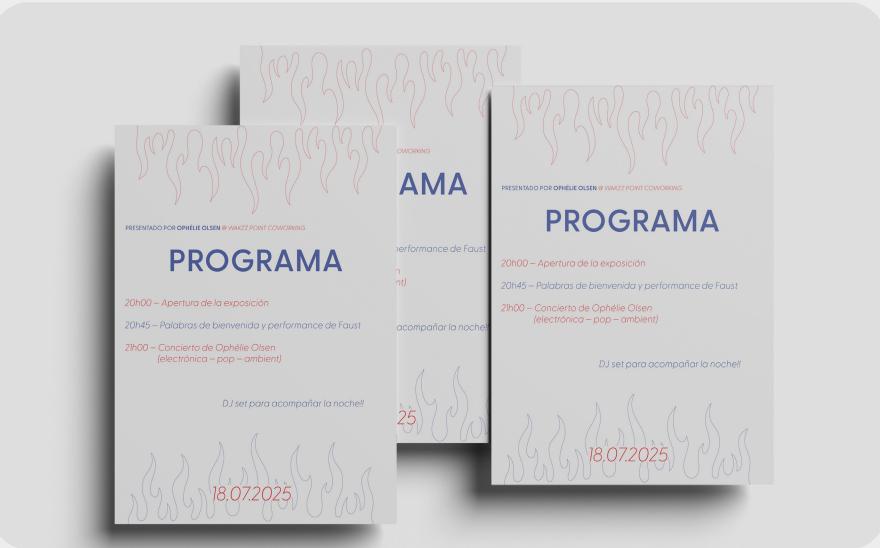
My name is Ophélie Olsen and l've been a designer for the last four years.

I wanted to design a strong visual identity, in order to create a whole universe around the event. The main assets to design were the poster, and the program.

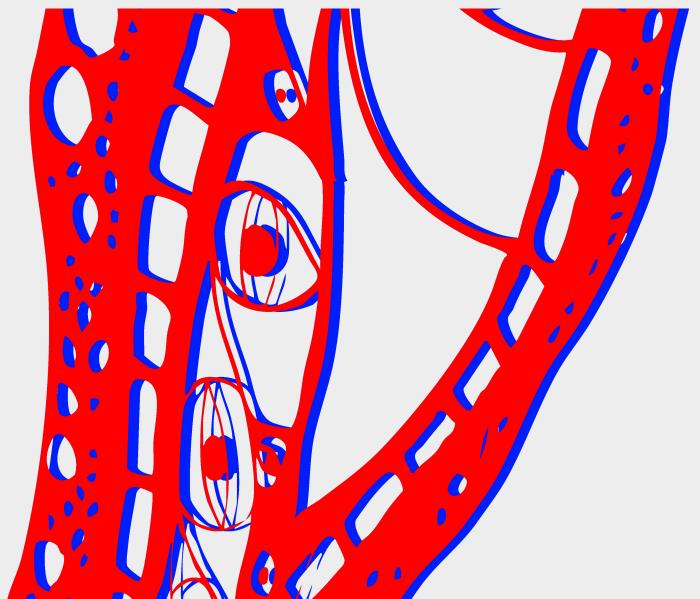

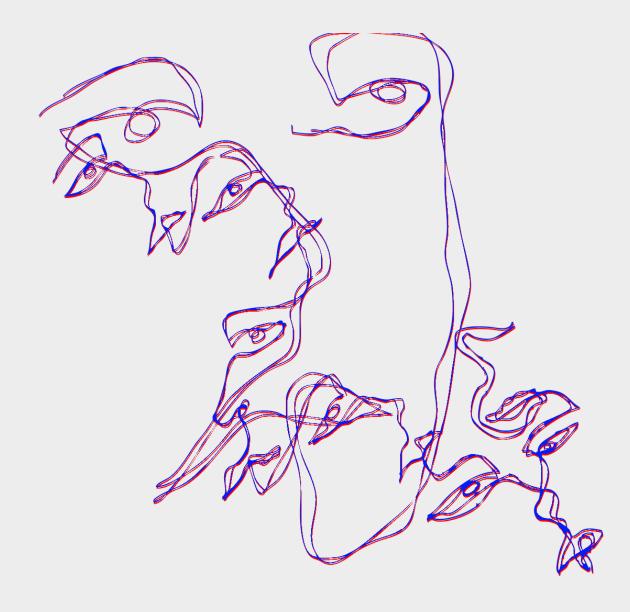
This project is a real introspection in my style and my inspirations.

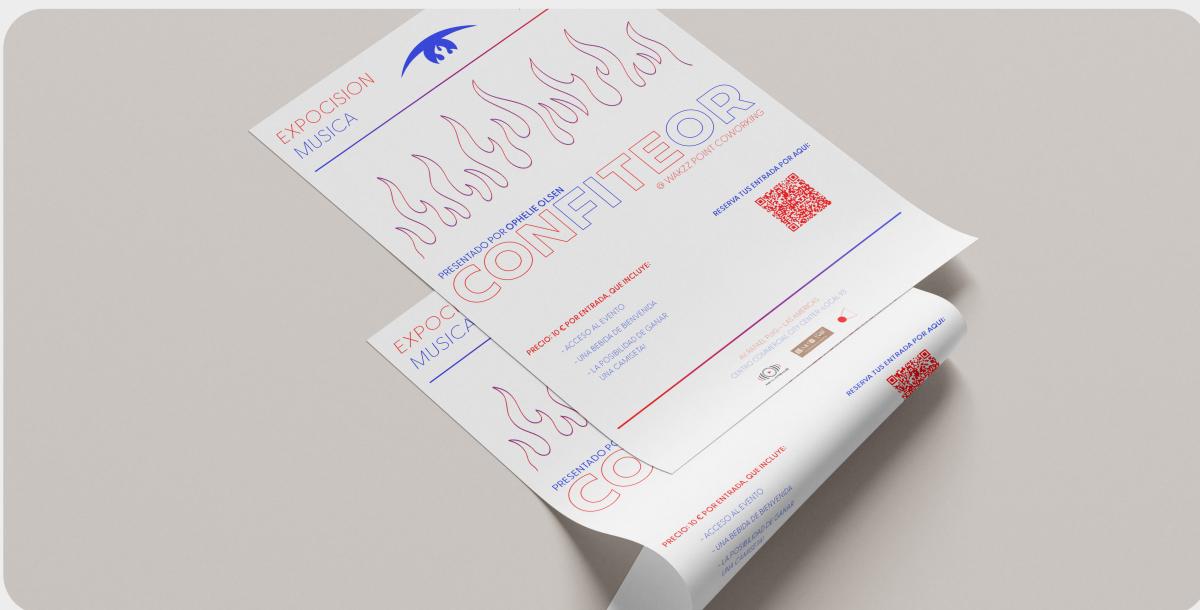

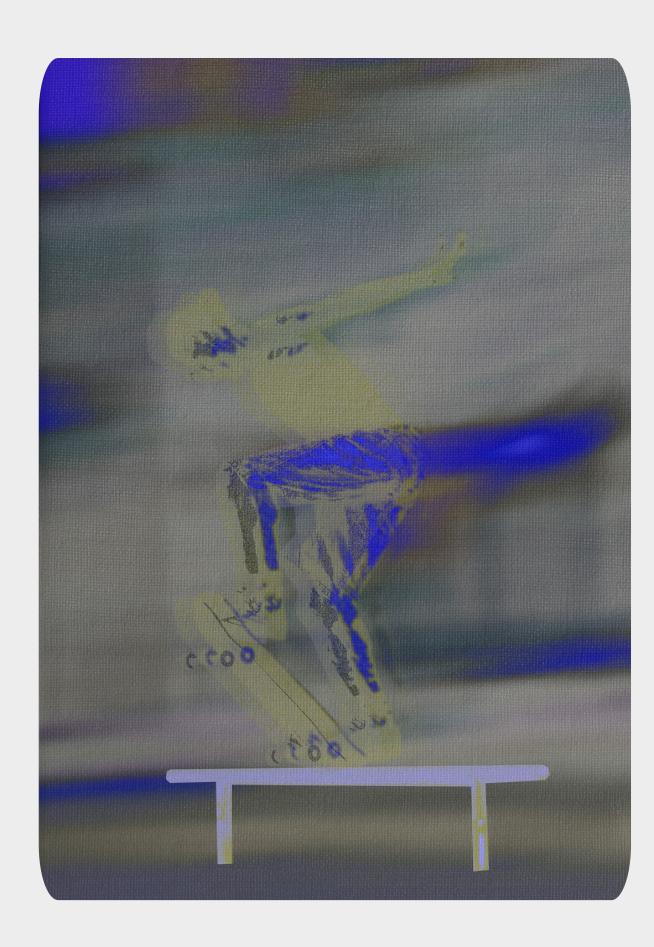
Skate in LA Photography

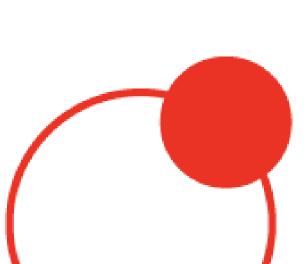
For this project I created their brand book and their visual identity. For their identity, the main challenge was that I wanted something that stands out, but without taking the place of the artists invited.

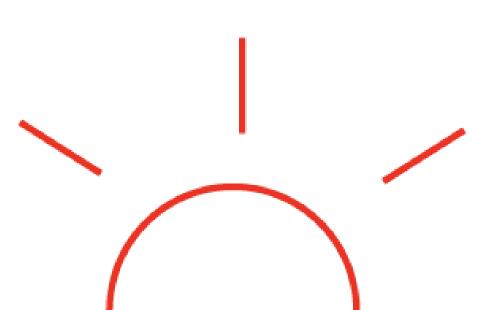
The wish for minimalism can also be seen in the color palette and the graphic elements.

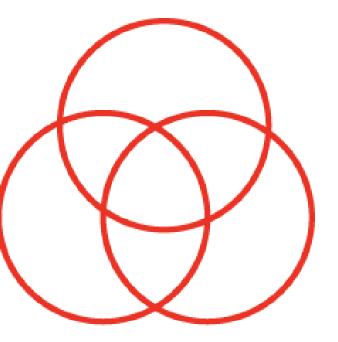
